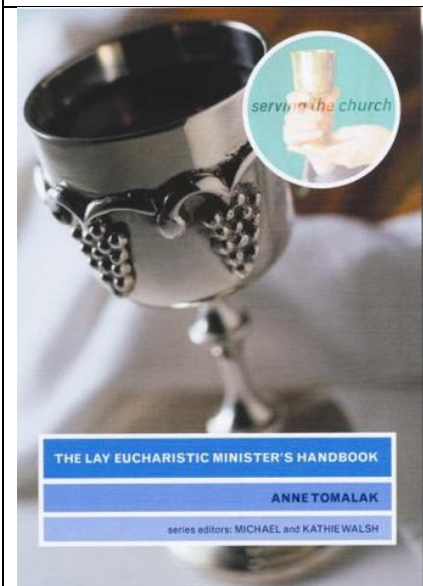

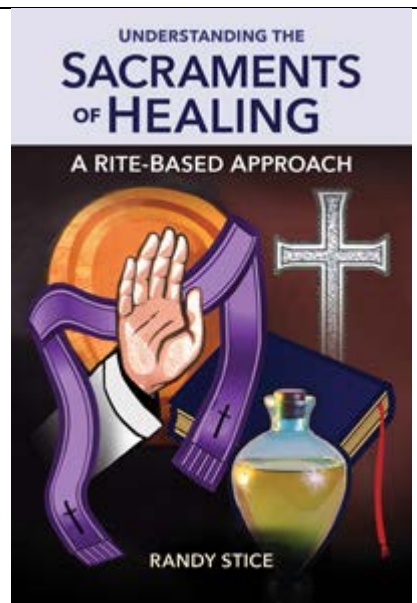

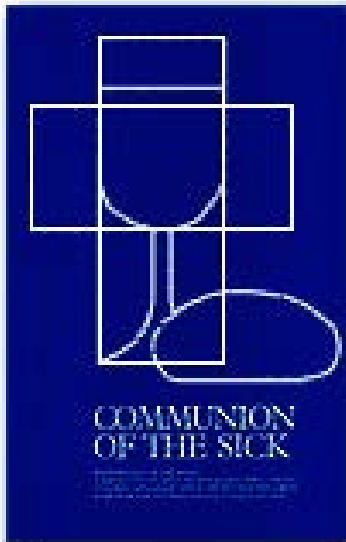

If the sick person is unable to receive the Eucharist, the priest or minister should bring the Eucharist to the sick person. If it is not possible to bring the Eucharist, the sick person should receive the Eucharist in the form of a wafer.
